No experience necessary to compete. The winners of each age group (0-11) and the Overall Most Beautiful Winners 0-11 and 12-up will sign a contract to advance to the state pageant. The state pageant is the Little Miss Magnolia State Pageant and will be held on September 19-20, 2026 at the Vicksburg City Auditorium in Vicksburg, Queens at the state pageant will receive \$1,000 CASH!!! It is a privilege to participate in the state pageant. We ONLY allow the winners of Magnolia State preliminary pageants or contestants sponsored by an official Miss Magnolia State Local Pageant Director to participate in state. Many do not get the chance to participate in the state pageant because they did not win their local pageant.

Contestants ages 0-11 will model a dress of her choice. The dress code is simple pageant dresses with only a few sequins or pearls, Easter type dress, or flower girl dresses that do not touch the floor. Please no glitzed national type pageant dresses. The dresses may have just a couple of tiny rhinestones or a rhinestone belt or strap but no full fledged glitzed out pageant dresses. If you question your dress, send the director a picture of it. The clothing is not being judged to choose the winner — the contestant is!! Also no fake hair, eyelashes, spray tans or flippers/fake teeth on kids are allowed for kids 11 and under. The 12-14, 15-17 age division and 18-Up and Mrs. divisions WILL need to wear long formal gowns! There are four side events that you are entered in free just by sending in your one low entry fee of \$65 — they include a Best Fashion award in each age division, a Prettiest Eyes Award, Prettiest Smile Award and a Prettiest Hair Award in each age division. Winners of each side award will win a certificate. If you have any questions, contact the director. We will not double-crown the Overall Most Beautiful Winner and an Age Group Queen. If the pageant is large enough we could add more Overall Awards. We will ad some optionals at the door but are not required to enter such as Optional Titles, Overall Photogenic Titles for 0-11 and 12 up and Jackpot Optional Titles. Contact the director for the Optiional Awards available.

The winners of the Junior, Teen and Miss divisions will represent their area at the Miss Magnolia State Pageant in Vicksburg on November 20-22, 2026. Junior, Teen and Miss contestants should have never had children or married. The Mrs. winner will represent her area at the Mrs. Magnolia State Pageant also held in Vicksburg on November 20-22, 2026. The winners of these divisions must sign contracts to attend the state pageant. State winners win a cruise or amazing vacation!

There will be up to three alternates in each division. Sorry, but due to prize expenses and building rental, refunds will not be given if you fail to show for the competition. Admission for everyone, except contestants, is \$10.00. Kids 3 and under will be admitted free.

The pageant will be held on Saturday, March 7 at 5 p.m. at Pelahatchie Attendance Center located at 213 S. Brooks Street in Pelahatchie. Registration will be from 4 to 4:30 p.m. You will need to get your contestant number at this time. You may call the director for directions to the pageant if needed.
